Antique Rose Garden Quilt

Featuring Floral Collection Antique Rose, Color Basic, Quilter's Basic, and Mrs. March's Collection by Lecien

Yardage Requirements:

1/2 yard total assorted pink prints3/4 yard total assorted dark brown prints1 1/2 yards total assorted cream and tan prints

Alternate strips: 1 1/2 yards #7242C Inner border: 1/4 yard #7244P

Outer border (cut lengthwise): 1 1/2 yards #7241C

Binding: 1/2 yard #7243C Backing: 4 1/3 yards


All seams are 1/4". Press seams toward the darkest fabric or press open to reduce bulk.

For each block cut:

- (1) 2 %" x 2 %" square pink print and cut in half diagonally
- (1) 3 %" x 3 %" square pink print and cut in half diagonally
- (6) 2 \(^8\)" x 2 \(^8\)" squares brown print and cut each in half diagonally
- (1) 2 3/8" x 2 3/8" cream print and cut in half diagonally
- (1) 3 %" x 3 %" cream print and cut in half diagonally
- (2) 5 ³/₄" x 5 ³/₄" cream print and cut each in half diagonally

Assemble each block as shown:

Repeat to make (18) blocks.



Trim each block leaving 1/4" seam allowance beyond the dark brown triangles.

Repeat to make 18 blocks.

Stitch the blocks together into 3 vertical rows. Measure the length of each row. If the rows are slightly different lengths, calculate the average length. Cut (2) lengthwise strips of fabric # 7242C. Each strip should measure 8" x the length of the pieced strips. Stitch an

alternate strip between each row of pieced strips.

Inner border:

Cut (5) strips 1 ½" x width of fabric

Stitch the inner border strips together forming one long piece. Measure the quilt top at the center point from top to bottom and cut 2 strips to that measurement. Stitch to the sides of the quilt top. Measure the quilt top from side to side across the center and cut 2 strips to that measurement.

Stitch to the top and bottom of the quilt top.

Outer border:

Cut (4) lengthwise strips 8 ½" wide. Measure quilt top as directed above to determine the length to cut each strip. Stitch outer borders to the quilt top.

Layer, baste and quilt. Bind using (7) strips of 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " binding.
